

## **Admission to First year Engineering 2009-10**

**1.0** The SIES Graduate School of Technology established in 2002 is run and administered by the South Indian Education Society, which has been accorded the South Indian Linguistic Minority status as per the provisions in the Constitution.

**1.1** Seats are available in the following categories:

- a) South Indian Linguistic Minority
- b) Institute Level/Management seats
- c) CAP/All India
- d) Against vacant seats after CAP Rounds

Percentage of seats available under CAP/Management/Minority/All India Quota will be decided by Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti, Bandra (E), Mumbai. The exact distribution of seats available under the above mentioned categories shall be notified by Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai/Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti before submission of applications forms.

However, it is made expressly clear that if, after issuance of this brochure, any seat(s) and admission(s) allocation difference exists, a separate notification will be made with appropriate details.

## **GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:**

**1.2** Candidates will be eligible for admission to the First Year Engineering Course as per the eligibility conditions listed below. (Refer notification Pravesh-2009/(27/09)/TE-1, dated 05.02.2009 and the subsequent notification/s if any)

a) They should be Indian Nationals and should have passed the HSC (Std.XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with subjects English, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and secured a minimum 50% marks i.e. not less than 150 marks out of 300 marks (minimum 45% marks i.e. not less than 135 marks out of 300 marks in case of candidates of backward class categories belonging only to Maharashtra State) in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics added together.

b) They should be Indian Nationals and should have appeared for the MHT-CET-2009 conducted by the Directorate of Technical Education Government of Maharashtra and should have obtained a non-zero score in the subjects Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics added together at MHT-CET-2009.

## **1.3. SOUTH INDIAN LINGUISTIC MINORITY CATEGORY**

**1.3(a)** Candidates eligible for admission to the First Year Engineering shall satisfy the general eligibility conditions of 1.2(a) and (b) and should have as their mother tongue either Tamil, Malayalam, Telugu, Kannada, Tulu or Konkani.

**1.3.(b)** Candidates seeking admission through the linguistic minority category should have domicile status in the State

of Maharashtra. They should submit an affidavit on a Rs.100/- stamp paper that they have a resident status in the State of Maharashtra and their mother tongue is any one of the six languages: Tamil, Malayalam, Telugu, Kannada, Konkani or Tulu.

**1.4 INSTITUTE LEVEL/MANAGEMENT CATEGORY**

As per the guidelines issued by Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai, Maharashtra from time to time.

**1.5. CAP/ALL INDIA**

The open category seats will be filled by the eligible candidates who satisfy the general eligibility condition of 1.2 (a) and (b) and are from the State of Maharashtra. Candidates under the All India Quota should satisfy the general eligibility conditions of 1.2 (a) and should have a valid AIEEE score (i.e. total score should be positive) for the year 2009-2010.

**1.6 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR J & K MIGRANT**

**CANDIDATES:**

Candidate should be Indian Nationals and should satisfy the general eligibility conditions of 1.2(a).

**1.7. Other Eligibility criteria for specialized branches of Engineering**

Candidates seeking admission to some special courses or under some special provisions have to fulfill the following additional eligibility criteria.

**Admission to Bio-Medical/Bio-Tech. Engineering**

**course:**

Candidates seeking admission to Bio-Medical/Bio-Tech. Engineering course should have passed in the subject of Biology in the qualifying examination in addition to fulfilling the eligibility criteria as mentioned in Rule No.1.2 (a) and (b).

Note: The Institute has applied for additional course in Bio-Technology (Intake 30) and increase in intake in the branches of Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering (90 to 120) and Computer Engineering (60 to 120) from the academic year 2009-10. The approval from All India Council For Technical Education is awaited for the same.

All students applying for admission under the Linguistic Minority/Management Category/ All India/Against vacant seats should fill in the prescribed application form available at the SIES Graduate School of Technology Office on payment of Rs.1000/-.(the application form can also be downloaded from the institute website [www.siesgst.com](http://www.siesgst.com) and should remit the cost of application while submitting the application form in the office).The beginning of the schedule of admission process will be published in the leading newspapers/institute website and will be displayed on the college notice board from time to time. The Completed application form together with attested copies of supporting documents mentioned below should be submitted in the college office.

**3.1** Incomplete application forms may not be considered and therefore, candidates should take care to fill in the form completely.

**3.2** If supporting documents are not in order, the application is

liable to be rejected.

**3.3.** Once the application form together with the attested copies of documents are submitted to the college office, candidates will not be permitted to change any entry or submit any fresh copies of documents subsequently.

**3.4.** Original documents should not be submitted with the application form. Only attested copies are required.

**3.5** In the event if any document submitted by the student or the information supplied by him/her is found to be false or incorrect, the admission granted to him/her is liable to be cancelled by the competent authority which would be the Principal.

**4.0** **Fees : The fee payable for the course will be intimated separately.**

Candidates shall also be required to pay the fees as prescribed by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti from time to time. Fees may be paid through the bank and the challan should be produced in the office while securing admission.

**4.1** **Refund of Tuition, development and other fees for cancellation of admission.**

As per the directives of Pravesh Niyamtran Samiti/Directorate of Technical Education/All India Council for Technical Education from time to time.

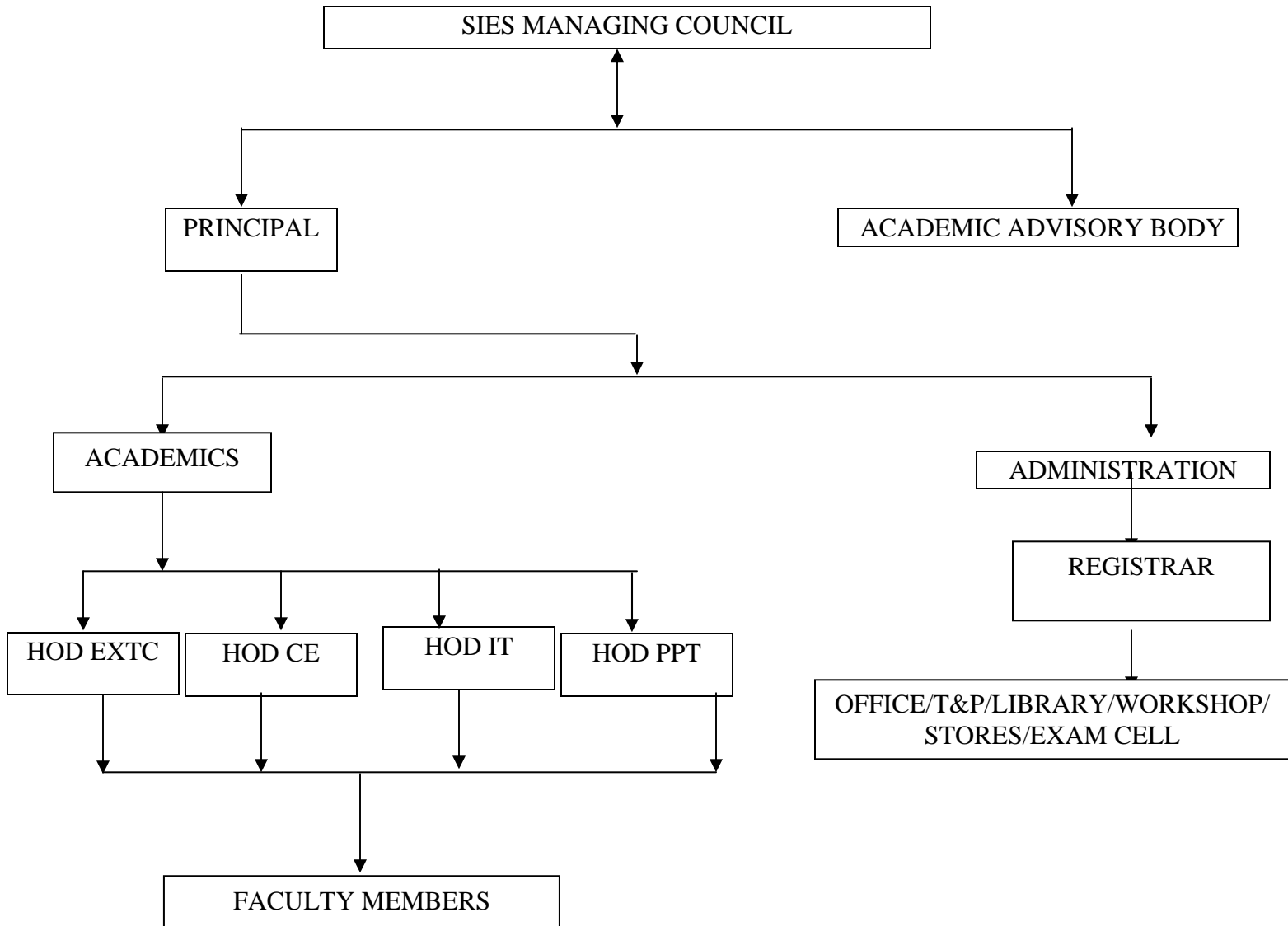
